## Best Practice Procedures for improved chemical safety

- Best Practice Procedures establish a standard course of action.
- They are written guidelines that explain what is expected and required to undertake a specific action and/or handle a specific chemical while following the best practices in chemical safety
- The aim of Best Practice Procedures is to explain in a simple but precise way the best practices to follow in the handling of each chemical or equipment, and should contain the necessary information to undertake operations in a safe way, under normal, start-up, shut-down, and abnormal (such as accident) conditions
